



## Directions

From Forth Road Bridge

Exit at Junction 2, follow signs for A985 Kincardine; 4 miles past Rosyth you pass under a small bridge, turn right immediately after this (signposted to Crossford). Follow the road into the village and turn right at the lights. The Logie House entrance is on the right hand side through two stone pillars.

From Glasgow / Kincardine Bridge

Follow A985 to Dunfermline until you come to a roundabout: take the A994 to Dunfermline: Crossford is the second village along this road.

From The North (M90)

Exit at Junction 3, following the A907 for Dunfermline Centre. Straight over at the roundabout, straight on at all lights; follow the A994 to Crossford.
